

SACRAMENTO VALLEY LFL MINUTES- JANUARY 18, 2004

President Roger Bohnhof opened the meeting with prayer. 15 were in attendance.

Roger made a presentation at Trinity Lutheran on January 11, 2004. He and Vice-President Wilbur Pullmann also spoke to the Pastor's Conference in Davis on January 13, 2004.

The California Pro-Life Council is having a breakfast on January 22, 2004, at a cost of \$25 per person. Norm Holt is making reservations for those from Zion who wish to attend. There will also be workshops and a rally at the State Capitol.

Minutes of the last meeting were approved as read. The treasurer's report was given and filed for review. Our balance is \$1,204.45.

Jim and Lois Brauer were thanked for their donation to buy publicity materials (bumper stickers, buttons, etc.)

Thrivent Matching Grant- Roger talked to a representative. They are still developing new forms and procedures for grants since the company reorganized. A motion was made and seconded to request support from them of \$2000 for State Rally expenses. After discussion, it was decided to withdraw the motion until we have more definitive information on the actual costs for the Rally.

State Rally- Confirmed speakers so far are Dr Jean Garton, Pastor Ista from San Rafael, and California LFL President Hans Neumann. We talked about having workshops so people could choose the topics that most interest them. This will require additional presenters. Some suggestions were Bud Reeves (who pickets at abortion clinics), attorney Cyrus Zal, Dean Lauer and Barbara Wilson from APRC, Heidi Hague (who gave up a child for adoption), and Beth Brauer (who adopted a child and was herself adopted). We may also want someone to address end-of-life issues. The Planning Committee will work on this and setting the schedule. (Betty Buchholz volunteered to also be on the Committee.) Wilbur has a person at Trinity who could print publicity flyers and posters. Suggested registration fees were \$25 per person, \$40 per couple, and \$10 per student or senior.

LWML Convention (April 23-25, 2004)- Linda Cruz has sent e-mails to the Convention Planning Vice-President to ask about the interest sessions, but has not received a reply. She will attempt to reach her by phone.

California LFL- They will have their next meeting on January 24, 2004 in Winnetka, CA and have asked Roger to attend. His airfare

will be \$142. It was moved, seconded and carried to reimburse him for this expense so that he can go.

The next Chapter meeting will be on Sunday, May 2, 2004 at 4:00 P.M. at Zion.
